



Initial Comprehensive Risk Assessment Information

The BaleDoneen Method Comprehensive Risk Assessment consists of review of your prior medical and dental records, survey and history information obtained through P3 (patient portal), lab testing including inflammatory, root causes identification, genetic tests and arterial wall/vascular evaluation. Appropriate arterial wall/vascular evaluation testing most often starts with a carotid intima media ultrasound (cIMT) **and if needed** a femoral intima (fIMT) and/or a CT coronary artery calcium score. Additional screening diagnostic cardiovascular tests may be necessary – on an individualized basis.

Lab tests (Blood, Urine, and Saliva) are also required and ordered for your assessment. The lab kits will be sent to your home. After the lab results are back, we will have a consultation with Dr. Pritchard and Coach Sydney to review your lab results and action plan and get started.
